RACE REGULATIONS

ARTICLE 1. ORGANISATION

The 49th Gran Premio Capodarco - Comunità di Capodarco is organised by G.S. Capodarco – Piazza della Libertà - 63900 Capodarco di Fermo (FM) – Contact person: Mr. Adriano Spinozzi – Via Castelfidardo, 18 – 63027 Fermo - Cell.- (+39)335-6780843 - fax (+39)0734-681228 – e-mail: adriano@gpcapodarco.net, will be held on 16th August 2021.

ARTICLE 2. TYPE OF RACE

In accordance with UCI regulations art. 2.1.005, the race is an International 1.2 MU Class event, included in the UCI Europe Tour calendar, reserved for Under 23 men for FCI and UCI affiliated clubs. In accordance with UCI regulations art. 2.10.008 and 2.10.031, the following points are awarded: 30 - 25 - 20 -15 -10 - 5 - 3 - 1 - 1 - 1 to the top 10 finishers. The race is held in accordance with UCI regulations. In keeping with anti Covid-19 regulations, the organiser will comply with all rules mentioned in the UCI-FCI protocols.

ARTICLE 3. PARTICIPATION

The event is by **invitation** and entries are to be made by **entry form** to be submitted to the organiser no later than 20 days before the date of the event. In order to be admitted, and in accordance with UCI regulations art. 2.2.003bis, teams must enter **5 (five) athletes**, without prejudice to art. 1.2.053, the team will not be allowed to participate with less than **4 athletes**. Italian UCI professional teams, foreign UCI professional teams (max.2), UCI continental teams, UCI cyclo-cross professional teams, national teams, regional and club teams are admitted. The team must confirm the names of the competing athletes and the two reserves 72 hours before the race. Rules contained in the entry form regulate possible participation expense reimbursements (hotel, meals, other expenses). Team sports managers are responsible for their athletes and other team personnel which are to be officially notified to the organiser at the time of accreditation.

ARTICLE 4. APPROVAL PAPERWORK

The event takes place on the designated race course as per the following annexed documents:

- Course map • Race profile • Race timetable • Map, profile and description of the last 3 km. to the finish line • Directions on race vehicle diversion • Race Director and Assistant Race Director statements • List including addresses of hospitals and emergency facilities along the course • Maps of the start and finish areas with the location of race headquarters including Race Jury, Anti-Doping Control, Secretariat, Press Room and Race Directors headquarters.

ARTICLE 5. RACE HEADQUARTERS AND STARTER CONFIRMATION

Race headquarters will be open from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM on Sunday 15th August 2021 and from 8:30 AM until 7:00 PM on Monday 16th August at the Teatro Comunale of Capodarco in Piazza della Libertà.

Starter confirmation and race number pick-up will take place on Sunday 15th August 2021 from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM at the Teatro Comunale of Capodarco in Piazza della Libertà.

ARTICLE 6. TECHNICAL BRIEFING

In accordance with UCI regulations art. 1.2.087, the technical briefing of the team managers with the Race Directors, the Commissaires' Panel and the FCI technical department delegate will be held at 8:00 PM on 15th August 2021 at the Teatro Comunale of Capodarco in Piazza della Libertà.

ARTICLE 7. "RACE SAFETY" BRIEFING

In compliance with UCI regulations art. 2.2.034 bis the meeting of the Race Directors with the Commissaires' Panel, the police, the drivers of official vehicles, safety motorcycles, photographers and tv operators that will be in the race convoy will be held at 11:00 AM on Monday 16 August at the Teatro Comunale of Capodarco in Piazza della Libertà.

ARTICLE 8. RACE START

The signing-on sheet is available for signing from 11:45 AM to 12:45 PM in Piazza della Repubblica. The starting ceremony will be held at Fabio Casartelli's Memorial, in via Giovanni XXIII at 1:00 PM. The neutralised start will take place at 1:15 PM and there will be a 5 km. neutralised section to the Cantina Santa Liberata on S.S. 16 Adriatica. The start proper will be at 1:30 PM.

ARTICLE 9. RAILROAD CROSSINGS

There are no railroad crossings.

ARTICLE 10. ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

The Anti-doping control location, in compliance with UCI – ITA (International Testing Agency) regulations, will be in the "Palestra Comunale", on the right hand side, 50 m. after the finish line. An anti-doping control can be requested also by Italian state authorities, in accordance with UCI regulations.

ARTICLE 11. RADIO-TOUR

The race may be followed only by accredited and authorized vehicles equipped with radio receivers able to tune into radio-tour service in Italian, French or English on the 149,850 MHz frequency.

ARTICLE 12. TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

Neutral service technical assistance will be provided by 4 duly equipped PREVITALI FSA Team cars. Technical assistance by motorcycle is permitted.

ARTICLE 13. PENALTIES

Penalties applied are those set forth in the UCI Regulations only.

ARTICLE 14. CLASSIFICATIONS AND PRIZES

The following classifications will be issued:

1. Individual Classification by time
2. Intermediate Sprints classification
3. King Of the Mountain classification

1. Individual classification by time

The individual classification is determined by the order in which the riders cross the finish line.

The following prizes are awarded to the top 20 finishers, as per the amounts established by International Regulations and Italian State laws. Athletes will be informed prior to the start of the race if there should be other extra-classification prizes as well as their assignation criteria in the event of a tie.

The total amount of the individual classification and special prizes is € **6,050.00**

This amount will be paid to the bank account of the ACCPI (Associazione Corridori Ciclisti Professionisti Italiani) - c/o Palazzo CONI - LCP/FCI - Via Piranesi 46 - 20137 MILANO - CF e P.IVA 07419480152) 7 days before the event and the ACCPI, based on the final classification approved by the Jury, will then take care of the subdivision and payment of the prize to each athlete and/or his/her proxy only by bank transfer.

The final prize may vary according to each athlete's taxation. At year end the ACCPI will then send an "overall certification" which must be included in the tax return.

SPECIAL PRIZES

2. Intermediate Sprint Classification

The I.S. classification is based on the sum of the points awarded at the I.S. indicated along the race course.

Points: 5 – 3 – 1 are assigned to the first three placements. In the event of a tie, first the number of wins in intermediate sprints and then the individual classification by time will be taken into consideration.

The winner will be awarded a gold medal

3. King of the Mountain Classification

The K.O.M. classification is based on the sum of the points awarded at the K.O.Ms. indicated along the race course.

Points: 5 – 3 – 1 are assigned to the first three placements. In the event of a tie, first the number of first places in the climbs and then the individual classification by time will be taken into consideration.

The winner will be awarded a gold medal and the Fabio Casartelli Trophy

ARTICLE 15. TIME LIMIT

A time limit of 8% of the race winner's time shall apply. This time limit may, in exceptional circumstances, be increased at the discretion of the Race Jury in agreement with the Organiser. (UCI regulations art. 2.3.039)

ARTICLE 16. FEEDING ZONE

The feeding zone, from team members standing on the side of the road or from authorised team cars following the race, starts from the 30th kilometre until 20 kilometres from the finish line, and from a fixed position from the 102nd to the 104th kilometre of the race between Paludi and the beginning of the climb to Capodarco.

ARTICLE 17. PROTOCOL

In fulfilment of UCI regulations art. 2.3.046, the first three finishers of the race and the winners of the secondary classifications (Intermediate Sprints and KOM) must appear at the podium near the finish line for the award ceremony within ten minutes of their having crossed the finish line.

ARTICLE 18. FIRST AID

First Aid will be given by two ambulances and the race doctor Dr. Matilde Gionni cell. (+39)392-4520903. The Hospital near the race course is in Fermo – Ospedale Murri – ph. (+39)0734-625111

ARTICLE 19. ECOLOGY

In fulfilment of U.C.I. dispositions to protect the environment the organisation has arranged two duly signposted "green zones", the first one on the climb towards Capodarco and the second one 500 m. after the KOM where participants must dispose of their waste rather than discarding it along the road and where there will be people in charge of collecting it at the end of the race.

Any infringement of this rule will be fined in accordance with UCI art. 2.2.025 and 2.12.007.

ARTICLE 20. ORGANISATION AND SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Given that the race takes place on widely used provincial and National roads, the Race Directors will take it upon themselves to withdraw any riders that may have accrued a considerable and insurmountable delay which would leave them out of the race's security zone, for their own safety as well as to cause the least possible inconvenience to other road users. The delay will be decided based also on the time determined by the permit and the temporary traffic suspension decree.

ARTICLE 21. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The race may be followed only by authorised personnel with specific technical duties or tasks given to them by the organisation. Furthermore, all people and vehicles must be accredited, have their passes and stickers and observe the law of the land in relation to road travel.

The Race Director must be notified promptly of any additions or modifications.


The Organiser declines all responsibility for any damage to spectators or other people, even if unrelated to the event, caused by accidents before, during or after the race, due to actions unrelated to the Organiser himself.

UCI and FCI regulations apply for any other issue that may not have been mentioned in this rulebook.
