



Combined indicator: 14-day notification rate, testing rate and test positivity, updated 27 July 2022

The latest weekly report (18 – 24 July) available for our region, Marche, states that there has been an incidence of 1020.08 new cases per 100,000 inhabitants which is why it has currently become a dark red zone.



14-day notification rate per 100 000 population weighted by vaccine uptake, EU/EEA Week 27, 2022

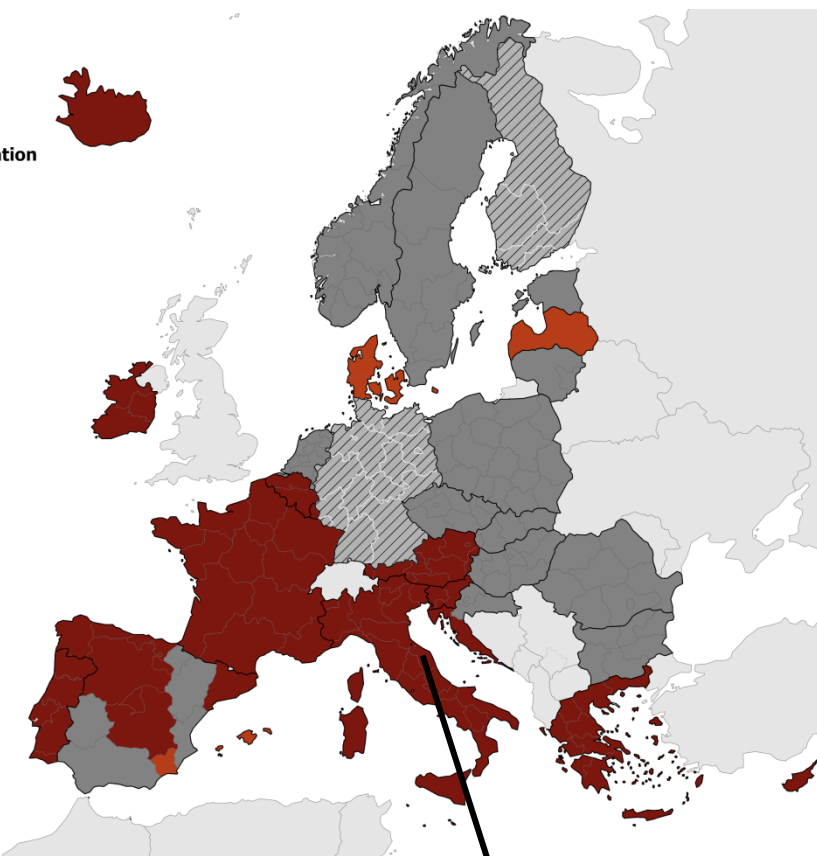
